Proposed 2017-18 Budget:

Motion made by Commissioner Alger and seconded by Commissioner Plaskov to remove \$80,000 intended for gas main capital asset materials from the Proposed 2017-18 Budget, and ask that Director Bonacci develop a plan to eliminate the deficit. All present were in favor and the motion was carried.

Gas Utility Capital Plan:

Motion made by Commissioner Alger and seconded by Commissioner Plaskov to engage Integrity Engineering for a not-to-exceed fee of \$10,000 for professional services related to identifying and monetizing recommended improvements for the gas utility and to assist BEGWS in developing a capital improvement plan to address all safety, reliability and operational items related to our gas system and infrastructure. All present were in favor and the motion was carried.

Adjourn Special Meeting/Executive Session:

Motion made by Commissioner Plaskov and seconded by Commissioner Becken to go into Executive Session at 6:33 p.m. to discuss personnel and contracts. Director Bonacci was asked to stay for Executive Session. All present were in favor and the motion was carried.

Return to Special Meeting:

Motion made by Commissioner Plaskov and seconded by Commissioner Alger to return to the Special Meeting at 7:08 p.m. All present were in favor and the motion was carried.

Engineering Planning Grant:

The Village of Bath was awarded an Engineering Planning Grant (EPG) by the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation for an amount of \$30,000 with a 20% cost share. The EPG was awarded based on the anticipated disinfection requirement in the WWTP's State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) Permit.

Motion made by Commissioner Becken and seconded by Commissioner Alger to authorize Director Bonacci to enter into an agreement with GHD Consulting Services to provide professional services related to the evaluation and design of disinfection improvements at the WWTP and other wastewater related improvements. The proposed disinfection improvements must be closely coordinated with the secondary treatment improvements. In order to proceed with the EPG, the motion also includes a request to present information to the Village Board at their next meeting to have the needed resolutions passed. All present were in favor and the motion was carried.

Maintenance Contract Renewal:

Motion made by Commissioner Alger and seconded by Commissioner Plaskov to approve payment of \$875.00 for the Autodesk renewal. All present were in favor and the motion was carried.

Adjournment:

Motion made by Commissioner Alger and seconded by Commissioner Plaskov to adjourn the Adjourned Special Meeting at 7:30 p.m. All present were in favor and the motion was carried.
